HISTORICAL POCKETS AND THEIR SOCIAL STORY A VIRTUAL STITCH WORKSHOP



The historical pockets we create will be based on those of the 16th -18th Century worn by women either under their skirts or outside their garments, tied around the waist and beautifully stitched or decorated with applique. Our online workshop will be focused on the history and creation of these very personal textile pieces.

We will guide you through the basic techniques of stitching a pocket and share some social historical background to the pockets and guidance for both absolute beginners and experienced stitchers in creating embroidered pockets.

The presentations will be given by textile designer Rebecca Cole-Coker and Melissa-Jo Smith, social historian and founder of Illuminated Arts.
